Sector 1: Food Security, Nutrition and Rural Development

General objective: Significantly reduce food and nutritional shortages

Specific objectives:

- ✓ Strengthening governance and budgeting for food and nutrition security
- ✓ Provide a permanent and sustainable access to available food in adequate quantity and quality
- ✓ To improve the nutritional status of children under five years and pregnant and lactating women

Expected results:

- The implementation of an integrated collaborative approach to resilience and fight against malnutrition is functional and effective
- Food security has improved
- The prevention and treatment of child and maternal under- nutrition are reinforced
- Chad's population has sustainable access to safe drinking water, equitable across regions, and access to drainage infrastructure, sanitation and good hygiene practices services has doubled in the hydro-outbreaks in the context of integrated management of water resources.

Sector 2: Sustainable management of natural resources

General objective: Promote wise and sustainable use of natural resources taking into account the needs of local people and reduce poverty

Specific objectives:

- ✓ Sustainable management of protected areas and fragile ecosystems
- ✓ Sustainable management of pastoral resources

Expected results:

- Pastoral farming systems are secure, valued and made profitable while contributing to the sound management of natural resources

Sector 3: Governance

General objective: Provide citizens with a transparent and functional government guaranteeing the protection of people, especially the most vulnerable, and good management of public assets.

Specific objectives:

- ✓ A public service of quality justice, fair and independent to protect the rights and guarantees citizens.
- ✓ The general climate of impunity and insecurity is dissipated through regulation and an effective operational framework forces Homeland Security
- ✓ Administration and Chadian citizens have access to a vital reliable recording.
- ✓ Public Finance Management is predictable, sustainable, and transparent, reflects the priorities of the population and is based on reliable data.

Expected results:

- Equal justice by a more efficient judiciary and judicial staff.
- Prison conditions have improved through better governance of prisons.
- Actions for the internal security of citizens and property are implemented as part of a national plan and strategic plans.
- The Organic Law on finance laws (OBL), resulting from the implementation of the CEMAC directive, after adoption, is implemented in order to enhance the performance and transparency of the state and public policy
- The state budget (including oil revenues) is powered by revenue diversified in order to reduce economic dependence on oil.

Civil Society

An indicative amount of 8-12 MEUR is earmarked for support to civil society. This support will enable a close synergy with subsidies (thematic programs of the EU, shutters "civil society" of EDF interventions and bilateral instruments of the Member States such the Social Fund for Development (SFD) in France), by equipping actors to better respond to calls for proposals, and with a cross support, and enabling greater involvement of the toughest players to achieve the thematic programs (eg. cultural, private sector, trade unions, universities etc.).

Other support measures

A Technical Cooperation Facility (TCF), aimed to support the programming, preparation or implementation of actions is provided by a specific allocation of an indicative amount of 6-9 MEUR for the period. It can only be used to support activities of limited amounts and not for small projects in additional areas to areas of concentration, or for actions related to the cross-cutting issues. Such actions should be financed within selected and / or via the specific allocation to support civil society sectors. An indicative amount of 6-7 MEUR is to support and strengthen the NAO's capacity to plan and monitor the implementation of a successful and time allotted by the ministries of interventions financed by the EDF and contribute to the effectiveness of aid.
