Sector 1: Employment and Education

General objective: To promote the use of quality trained human capital

Specific objective:

- ✓ Improve the quality of services of technical education and vocational training to meet the economic and social realities.
- ✓ Improve the conditions of access to employment for the most vulnerable groups through the adoption of active employment policies and cross-participation of key stakeholders.
- ✓ Facilitate the creation of decent jobs, including through the promotion of "green" jobs and self-employment
- ✓ Fight against inequality and gender inequality in access to education, employment and entrepreneurship.

Expected results:

- Skills training is reinforced and adapted to the needs of the economy and the employability is improved.
- Existing curriculum provide opportunities for primary and secondary school leavers
- A true public-private partnership allows to anticipate future developments in labor supply and its structure and prepare the corresponding challenges, especially for jobs in the green economy.
- Young people wishing to engage in entrepreneurship benefit from a favorable legal framework and adequate support
- Job quality is improved by the reduction of employment in the informal sector for formal employment
- Reducing the dropout rate among young women engaged in TVET.

Civil Society

Funding to civil society is integrated in the sector mentioned above. Moreover, civil society receives funding through the thematic program "Non-State Actors and Local Authorities" with which it will be looked for synergies, particularly in the context of the cooperative support of women working in agriculture in rural areas, population particularly affected by the lack of training and employment opportunities.

Other support measures

A Technical Cooperation Facility (TCF), aimed to support the programming, planning and implementation of activities is planned for a total of 1 MEUR. A maximum indicative amount of € 500,000 is provided to support the NAO.
