Sector 1: Rule of law & Governance

General objective: to consolidate the rule of law and democracy and transform the administration to accomplish development needs.

Specific objective:

- ✓ Administration modernized and provides socio-economic services in a reliable and transparent way
- ✓ Access for all to an independent, fair and quality justice is improved and the safety of property and persons is ensured in respect of human rights,
- ✓ Democratic culture and respect for equality of opportunities is promoted across the society

Expected results:

- ✓ The institutional framework of the public services delivery is strengthened at central and local level
- ✓ Guinean civil service is enhanced through modern Human Resources management policy based among others on adequate training
- ✓ Public Administration has the information and statistics needed to carry its tasks and has the tools to report on its activities and monitor and evaluate its performance.
- ✓ Access for all, especially for the most vulnerable, with an independent, fair and quality judiciary is consolidated and the gradual renewal of the workforce continues
- ✓ Modernization of internal security services continued throughout the territory, including the socio-economic reintegration of staff whose profile responds more to the needs of the defense and security forces.
- ✓ The commitment roadmap with civil society will be finalized early in 2015 with the support of the program PASOC financed under the 10th EDF and the results fully integrated into the instruction of the 11th EDF.

Sector 2: Urban water & Sanitation

General objective: to improve urban sanitation management, particularly in Conakry and other urban centers in Guinea, to accelerate the achievement of MDGs, particularly Infant mortality, diseases and environment.

Specific objectives:

- ✓ An urban policy is prepared and adopted, including land and other key areas for safety.
- ✓ Infrastructure and sanitation services are in place in the capital and in secondary cities, complying with sanitation policies covering waste management, waste and rain water and air quality.

Expected results:

- ✓ An administrative and regulatory framework is in place for the management of territory sanitation and urban planning, setting priorities and strategic lines in key areas for urban sanitation (water, sanitation, urban transport, etc.)
- ✓ Sanitation infrastructure is in place in the capital and in secondary cities, according to sanitation policies covering waste management, wastewater and rainwater and air quality.
- ✓ A solid management and waste collection system is improved, generalized and perpetuated, and the presence of garbage in the streets is reduced.
- ✓ The collection and management of wastewater and storm-water systems are extended, improved and
- ✓ Urban jobs are created through intensive labor actions; public works implemented by small and medium enterprises (SMEs) and construction of more large-scale infrastructure for drainage of rainwater.

Sector 3: Health

General objective: to accelerate the achievement of the MDGs, in particular the reduction of mortality improving infant and maternal health through building health support systems.

Specific objectives:

- ✓ Improving the governance of the health system at central and regional levels to ensure that the system is coherent, efficient and sustainable in its whole and has the human, material and financial resources needed.
- ✓ Improving access to essential quality care in the intervention areas (forest regions and urban centers in Conakry in complementarity with other partners)

Expected results:

- ✓ The financing of the health sector and recovery policies are insured and health insurance policies will gradually be set up for the benefit of the most vulnerable groups, as well as mothers and children.
- ✓ Surveillance and rapid response capabilities to outbreaks and any other threat impeding the efficiency and effectiveness of the health system is strengthened, with a strong focus of attention in the Ebola crisis
- ✓ In areas where possible, and particularly in urban and mining areas, a partnership with the private sector is established or improved.
- ✓ The necessary health personnel is present at health centres; and the management and training of human resources are adequate as well as the management of physical, administrative and financial resources;
- ✓ Health infrastructures are rehabilitated and their staffing and equipment and medicines is improved

Sector 4: Transport

Overall objective: to contribute to economic and social development, the fight against poverty and regional integration through a quality road network, managed and maintained in an appropriate and sustainable way.

Specific objective:

- ✓ Contribute to improving governance in the transport sector, through the definition of an appropriate strategy in the medium and long term and the sustainability of the achievements
- ✓ Enhance and extend the studies to finalize the rehabilitation works of the major roads of the country (roads RN1-4) by blending with other private or public partners.

Expected Results:

- ✓ An appropriate sectoral policy is adopted consolidating sector liberalization of road transport, improving the quality of programming and implementation of road maintenance and sustainability of the primary road network

- ✓ Structures are in place and consolidated for the effective implementation of different provisions on technical control and road safety as well as control of axle load (with enforcement of sanctions for offenders), thus contributing to the restoration of state authority in this area.
- ✓ The studies are completed with Coyah-axis on the RN1 Mamou, Mamou, Faranah on RN2 and the coastal highway (bypass between Conakry and Coyah Dubréka)
- ✓ The fixtures are organized in blending with financial partners e.g. development banks, and the mining sector, to complement the works on RN1-4.
