Sector 1: Governance and strengthening of public policies

General objective: to contribute to strengthening the rule of law and democracy for inclusive growth.

Specific objectives: Strengthen the capacity of the state to consolidate economic development, stability and delivery of basic public services

Expected results:

- Public management and Fiscal transparency are improved
- The effective functioning of the public administration is improved
- Accountability of public administration and the fight against corruption are enhanced
- The benefits of basic services is improved

Sector 2: Infrastructure supporting economic development

General objective: to strengthen the capital "infrastructure" support to economic development

Specific objective: Improve infrastructure for cluster development with high economic potential and ensure their sustainability

Expected results:

- The mobility of people and goods is improved by rehabilitating road connections
- Access to electricity has increased
- Access to drinking water in the capital and its suburbs has improved
- Management and sustainability of investments are enhanced by accompanying measures

Sector 3: Rural development

General objective: to promote a competitive and sustainable agricultural sector and strengthen the resilience of vulnerable populations to food and nutrition insecurity.

Specific objective:

- ✓ Better governance of the sector to enable an inclusive agricultural growth and sustainable use of natural resources.
- ✓ Improve productivity, profitability and sustainability of agricultural value chains
- ✓ Improve food and nutrition security and resilience of rural households

Expected results:

- The public institutions are operational and accompany the implementation of sector reforms.
- The legislative and regulatory framework has improved and promotes investment while respecting the environment.
- The capacity of training, consultancy and research are strengthened for the benefit of stakeholders.
- Value chains are promoted through investments in infrastructure (rural roads, irrigation) and better access to finance.
- Nutrition education is promoted and strengthened.
- People's resilience to the effects of crises and climate change has improved.
