Sector 1: Food security and sustainable agriculture

General objective: to strengthen the resilience of vulnerable populations to food and nutrition insecurity in Mauritania.

Specific objective:

- ✓ Strengthening governance for equitable access and sustainable resource management in the context of climate change.
- ✓ Improve sustainable and equitable access to services and basic infrastructure for vulnerable populations.
- ✓ Promote the development of sustainable supply chains at family and community levels.

Expected results:

- Institutional, technical and organizational actors in sustainable agriculture and food security at the national and local capacities are strengthened,
- Governance in terms of access to resources for rural populations has improved,
- Effective information for food and nutrition security systems are established.
- The qualitative and quantitative needs sanitation and improved water for all needs and activities of all rural populations throughout the year

Sector 2: Rule of law

General objective: to contribute to the consolidation of democracy and conflict prevention.

Specific objectives:

- ✓ Strengthen devolution and decentralization of local services to better serve local populations,
- ✓ Promote access to justice independent and credible guarantor of respect for human rights,
- ✓ Strengthen integrated border management and the management of public services and professional security officers,
- ✓ Contribute to the prevention of conflicts, especially by strengthening the system of supports to youth employment.

Expected results:

- The capacity for project management, financial management and management of local and decentralized services communities are strengthened with the participation of CSOs
- The equitable and inclusive access to efficient and independent services in the justice sector is strengthened
- National integrated border management (police, gendarmerie, customs) is performing

- Cross-border coordination of enforcement authorities (police, gendarmerie, customs) is effective
- Capacity and specialization, including at management level, the body responsible for security are defined and strengthened and include respect for human rights

Sector 3: Health

General objective: to sustainably improve the health of populations and mitigate the impact of poverty on the most vulnerable groups by supporting and strengthening the implementation of the National Health Development Plan 2012-20.

Specific objectives:

- ✓ Allow equitable access to primary health care quality and use of access;
- ✓ Improving equitable and sustainable availability of human resources for health, and quality;
- ✓ Improve the availability and accessibility of quality essential medicines.

Expected results:

- High priority is given by the Ministry of Health for the development of primary health care services at the decentralized level
- The Ministry of Health is supported in its efforts, particularly in pressing for the creation of high-impact interventions in maternal and child health, including nutrition, in at least one Wilaya
- The performance of services is improved through i) an increase of financial resources; ii) decentralize and / or empowerment; and iii) capacity building for planning, management, and monitoring and evaluation including the strengthening of national health information system (HMIS).
- A system of forward planning of human resources is established taking into account the needs of their redeployment
- National capacities to meet the initial training quantitative and qualitative needs of the sector, and include nutrition
- The skills of health personnel are continuously effectively and sustainably improved by strengthening the ongoing training and supervision.

Civil Society

No specific projects for civil society organisations are envisaged in this programme.

Technical cooperation facility

A Technical Cooperation Facility (TCF), aimed at supporting the identification and formulation of projects / programs or support for the implementation of specific actions is provided in the program through a specific grant. It will (i) have a fund for the sector studies; (ii) fund the missions of identification and formulation of projects / programs, (iii) mobilize technical expertise on topics not covered by other institutional support, particularly for the formulation of the next PRSP and support for the management of public support; (iv) establish a training plan for all stakeholders Cooperation, (v) fund the participation of local actors in conferences, ad hoc studies and international seminars. A maximum indicative amount of 6,5 MEUR is provided to support the services of the NAO.
