Sector 1: Water and Sanitation

General objective: Improve sector governance and the provision of drinking water and access to sanitation in rural and peri-urban services, creating the basic conditions necessary for the improvement of social, economic, environmental, and health, particularly reducing the incidence of waterborne diseases.

Specific objective: Improving access to safe drinking water and an efficient sewerage system for people, environmentally sustainable and resilient to climate change.

Expected results:

- Improving access to safe drinking water and an efficient sewerage system for the people.
- Increased adequate and sustainable access of the population to potable water.
- Increase production capacity of sector institutions, as part of an integrated management of water resources.
- Improving access to sustainable sanitation.

Sector 2: Agriculture

General objective: Promote economic recovery and job creation by strengthening agricultural export sectors.

Specific objectives: Improve the quality and increase the amount of national sustainable production of traditional and new export crops.

Expected results:

- The state support (research institutions, training and agricultural extension) structures provide effective and sustainable valuable services to various stakeholders for technical and organizational support of replanting, improving product quality and marketing.
- The capacity of the Ministry of Agriculture to change the legal framework based on the needs of producers and maintain updated data throughout the sector is enhanced, facilitating the development, maintenance and operation of systems information on the economic, social, land and plant resources industry aspects; and its ability to operate, analyze and disseminate this information is developed.
- Sustainable agricultural productivity of crops for export and profitability of production units in the sector increase
- Product quality for export and recognition on destination markets has improved

Civil Society

There is no provision for specific budget for civil society. Nevertheless, the involvement of civil society will be integrated into the implementation of the two focal sectors. In addition, civil society has to support capacity building through the funding of the thematic program "Non-State Actors and Local Authorities" and other thematic lines with which it will be searched synergies.

Other support measures

A Technical Cooperation Facility (TCF), aimed to support the programming, planning and implementation of activities is planned for an indicative amount of 0,5 MEUR. A maximum indicative amount of 0,5 MEUR is expected to support the NAO.
