Sector 1: Governance

General objective: to contribute to the strengthening of democratic governance

Specific objectives:

- ✓ Contribute to strengthening the rule of law and improving access to justice through an independent, efficient, transparent and non-discriminatory justice system.
- ✓ Strengthen transparency and integrity in governance.
- ✓ To prevent and reduce internal and external factors of destabilization of the state.

Expected results:

- Strengthening of the local justice (justice centers, mediation system), strengthening the quality of public service of justice (including through the training of Justice), support to the implementation of the reform of the judicial system
- The fight against corruption and impunity is reinforced
- The effectiveness of public expenditure and accountability is improved
- Strengthen integrated border management and the ability, professionalism and accountability of public services responsible for security
- The electoral process is credible and is no longer a risk of destabilization and disruption of public order

Sector 2: Agriculture and Food security

General objective: to help improve the food security of populations

Specific objectives:

- ✓ To improve prevention and response to food and nutrition crises;
- ✓ Improve sustainable and resilient to climate change and agricultural productivity;
- ✓ Promoting market access and food availability;
- ✓ Improving governance for sustainable management of inputs and marketing of agricultural products.

Expected results:

- A better warning system is established, backed by a system of crisis management to mitigate the effects of early food and nutrition crises
- Acute and chronic child malnutrition and infant mortality are reduced
- Factors of production are improved, while protecting natural resources is ensured (restoration of degraded land, seed capital and energy) including recovery and development of land for irrigation.
- Water resources (surface water, groundwater) are sustainably managed (IWRM).
- Access to electricity (including "green" electricity) in rural areas has improved
- Marketing of agricultural products is improved.

Sector 3: Water and Sanitation

General objective: to improve the living conditions of populations (especially the most vulnerable), and sanitary environment (through improved access to water and sanitation as part of a integrated management of water resources).

Specific objectives:

- ✓ Improve access and correct access to safe drinking water in rural areas
- ✓ Improve access and correct disparities in access to adequate sanitation
- ✓ To ensure the preservation of the heritage of drinking water and sanitation infrastructure

Expected results:

- Populations benefit from greater access to drinking water and sanitation
- Releases to the environment are less polluting, the quality of water resources is better preserved;
- The impact of flooding is reduced through better management of wastewater and rainwater
- The work of heavy maintenance and replacement of facilities for production, storage and distribution of drinking water are programmed according to a response plan prioritized and integrate potential risks associated with climate change in their design.
- The regulation of drinking water and sanitation sector in rural areas is provided by a public body composed equally, which sets the parameters for the relationship between state supervision, water producers, service providers and consumers as part of an integrated management of water resources.

Civil Society

Future support to civil society will be incorporated into the three areas of concentration and complement the Program of Support to Civil Society Initiatives initiated in 2013 on the 10th EDF, amounting to EUR 5.5 million, which aims to (i) promote citizen involvement in governance of public affairs, particularly in key sectors of the EU-Senegal cooperation and (ii) build the emerging movements for citizenship.

Other support measures

A support facility designed to support the programming, preparation or implementation of actions is planned. It is not considered as a sector and can be programmed outside the permitted ceiling of three sectors. It will be used to support activities in limited amounts. It will not be used or to finance small projects in additional areas or for actions related to cross cutting issues sectors. Support to the NAO will continue. The indicative allocation to the NAO is 5 MEUR.
